Dear Mr. May and Mr. Belval:

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation-East, under 18 C.F.R. ¶ 375.307, your submittal filed in the above referenced docket is accepted for filing, effective April 18, 2010, as requested.

On February 16, 2010, you filed, on behalf of the ISO New England Inc. and the New England Power Pool, revised tariff sheets¹ describing two changes to the ISO New England Financial Assurance Policy and the ISO New England Billing Policy (together, the Policies). You state that these changes clarify the prepayment and suspension provisions of the Policies.

Public notice of the instant filing was issued on February 17, 2010, with comments, interventions, and protests due on or before March 9, 2010. Pursuant to Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2009), all timely filed motions to intervene and any motions to intervene out-of-time filed before the issuance date of this order are granted. No protests or adverse comments were filed.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of any rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against your company.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713 (2009).
