On July 31, 2008, you filed an informational report which identifies updated rates for regional transmission and scheduling, system control and dispatch services effective as of June 1, 2008 under Section II of the ISO New England Inc. Transmission, Markets and Services Tariff, FERC Electric Tariff No. 3. Your filing in the above referenced docket is accepted for informational purposes.

Public notice of the filing was published in the Federal Register with comments, protests or interventions due on or before August 21, 2008. No protests or adverse comments were filed.
