DATA REQUESTS

CT/ISO 5-1.

CT/ISO 5-2. Please provide an Excel Spreadsheet containing the following data for all hours in which Day-Ahead Net Commitment Period Compensation (“DA NCPC”) payments were made to capacity importers across the Northern New York AC Interface for the period from December 1, 2005 through August 31, 2009, regardless of whether there was an offsetting transaction by the capacity importer or its affiliate:

- a. the date and hour(s) of the transaction;
- b. the name of the importer;
- c. the price of the importer’s offer;
- d. the Locational Marginal Price at the external node where the transaction occurred;
- e. the applicable DA NCPC amount;
- f. any reduction applied to the DA NCPC amount by application of the rule changes made effective on October 17, 2007 in Docket No. ER08-61 (the “exigent circumstances rule”);
- g. any payments made by the importer in the Real-Time Energy Market for transactions that did not flow; and
- h. the net payment made to the importer.
